DO YOU WANT YOUR RAM LAMBS INSPECTED? FOR 2014 & 2015 THE ASSOCIATION IS TRIALLING SELF INSPECTION. Ram pro-formas will be sent out with DSBA ram tags in the autumn. For a ram to be entered into the flock book, the proforma must be fully completed and returned to the Secretary by 30th November 2014.

For flocks that have had registered less then FIVE crops of ram lambs an inspection will be required for any potential ram lambs.

Other ram lamb inspections can be done if requested.
