Notice to potential purchasers of Greyface Dartmoor sheep.

- ✚ Only members of the DSBA may register lambs born within their flock.
- ✚ Only lambs born to registered Greyface Dartmoor sheep can be registered with the DSBA. Both sire and dam must be registered.
- ✚ There is no grading up process for unregistered Greyface Dartmoor sheep.
- ✚ Registered male sheep have a small silver tag in their ear with a four-digit number stamped on it.
- ✚ Registered female sheep will have either a small metal tag with the year of birth, flock number and individual tag. OR from 2018, a plastic white tag with DM 2018 and the flock number.
- ✚ For ewe lambs, the tags have only just gone out to members, however those with registered sheep have been issued with pedigree certificates.
- ✚ If you purchase unregistered sheep, they and their progeny are not eligible for entry into the DSBA flock book.
- ✚ As always, buyers beware.
